Vellore Institute of Technology (VIT) was founded in 1984 as Vellore Engineering College by Chancellor Dr. G. Viswanathan. VIT attracts students from all 29 states of India and more than 41 different countries because of its academic excellence. VIT was established with the aim, to provide quality higher education on par with international standards. VIT has been constantly ranked among the best Universities and is aspiring to emerge as a global leader.
